

GRAPES Booth attracts interest at 2011 APEC Conference

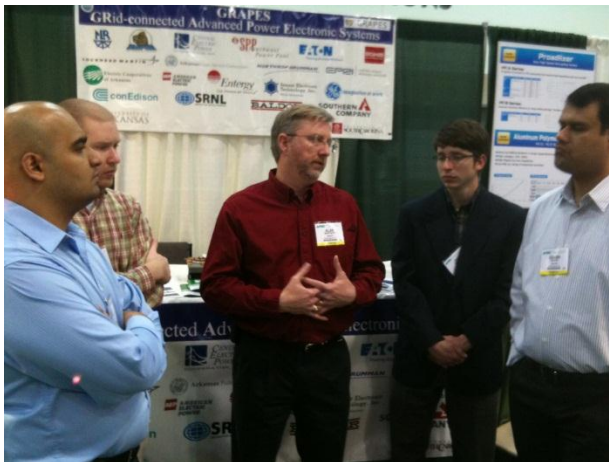
