

USC Hosts GRAPES 4th Semiannual Meeting May 17-18, 2011

Columbia, SC – The NSF I/UCRC GRid-connected Advanced Power Electronic Systems (GRAPES) Center held its 4th semiannual meeting May 17-18 in Columbia, SC at the University of South Carolina main campus. The two-day meeting consisted of current project updates, new project proposals and student poster presentations.

This meeting also marked the first meeting of the Industrial Advisory Board (IAB) under new leadership.
